### Job Summary

The .NET Developer will assist one or more Senior Developers to identify, prioritize and deliver technology-related solutions that continually meet or exceed stakeholder expectations. With appropriate supervision from one or more Senior Developers, the Developer then works independently and/or with others to deliver solutions of varying complexity that is consistent with the Technology Division's mission, strategies, plans, standards and guidelines.

### Primary Responsibilities

- Program objects, events, functions, error trapping and data verification
- Adhere and contribute to development policies, procedures and standards
- Review current systems and present ideas for system improvements
- Work closely with analysts, designers and staff
- Produce detailed specifications
- Test the product in controlled, real situations before going live
- Perform system maintenance on an ongoing basis

- Minimum 2 years experience with C# or VB, ASP.NET and SQL Server OR Associates degree\* with Computer Science, Computer Information Technology, Programming or similar field of coursework required
- Some development experience preferred
